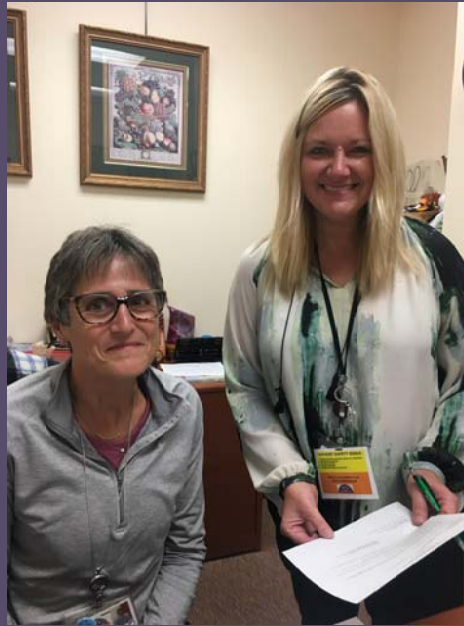

Post Acute Care Services at FCMC

FULTON COUNTY MEDICAL CENTER offers several post acute care services whether you need a short stay or a little longer. FCMC reviews all referrals and on a case-by-case basis. We will find the appropriate fit for you or your loved one. You can choose from **swing bed, short or long term care.**

Swing Bed

This program allows patients switching from their acute care hospital stay to skilled care status while remaining in the same room at the hospital but at a different level of care.

Additionally, patients who were treated at another hospital and meet the qualifying criteria may also come to the Fulton County Medical Center for their recovery.

While every patient is different, a typical swing bed stay is seven to ten days. Swing bed services are covered through Medicare Part A, up to 100 days. Other insurances may also cover swing bed service after appropriate authorization.

Eligibility

To qualify, Medicare beneficiaries must:

- be under the supervision of a physician
- have three day acute hospital stay prior to entering the swing bed program
- require skilled nursing or therapy services

Daily skilled nursing services

include:

post-fracture recovery, wound care, IV medications, pain management, ostomy care and teaching.

Daily skilled therapy includes:

physical, occupational, and speech therapy.
